RIB THROWDOWN RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1) Anyone can enter. Cook by yourself or as a team.
- 2) Entry fee is \$70.00 per cook/team. (NEW)
- 3) WE supply the ribs (Baby Back). Each cook/team will be responsible for cooking 4 rib slabs.
- 4) Fire must be wood or charcoal, NO PROPANE OR GAS IS ALLOWED.
- 5) Containers will be handed out prior to turn-in.
- 6) You are responsible for observing prudent temperature and sanitary requirements at all times.
- 7) All contestants are expected to respect the rights of all parties involved in the event.
- 8) Each team will consist of a Chief Cook and as many assistants as the Chief Cook deems necessary.
- 9) All seasoning / cooking of the product shall be done within the confines of the team's cooking space.
- 10) Additional food and beverages will not be available during the day. You may bring your own food/drink.
- 11) T-Shirts will be available for purchase at the event. S/M \$10 L/XL/2X-\$15

SET UP

- 1) Each cook/team will be assigned a space. Contact Keith Coe for space requirements.
- 2) Limited electricity will be provided. No generators are allowed.
- 3) Cooks are welcome to arrive/set-up the Friday night prior to event.
- 4) Small tents or umbrellas are permitted for shade.
- 5) Each cook/team will provide their own smoker/grill/cooker.
- 6) Each cook/team will bring their own cooking seasonings, sauces, rubs, and cooking equipment/utensils.

JUDGING

- 1) Entries will be judged by a pre-selected panel of judges.
- 2) Entries will be judged in the areas of 1) APPEARANCE 2) TASTE 3) TEXTURE
- 3) NO garnish will be allowed in the turn-in box.
- 4) NO sauce containers will be allowed in the turn-in box.
- 5) Entries may be presented with or without sauce or seasonings.
- 6) If you choose to use a sauce with your entry, it must be applied to the meat. Sauce cannot be pooled in the container.
- 7) Marking or sculpting of any kind, of the meat or of the container, will not be allowed.
- 8) No aluminum foil or stuffing is allowed in the container.
- 9) No toothpicks, skewers or foreign material are permitted in the container. Any entry not complying with this rule will be disqualified.
- 10) Each cook/team must turn-in 6 individual pieces of meat (6 "single" bones), No Garnishments.
- 11) Turn-in time is on or before 3:00 pm sharp. Late entries will not be accepted.

PRIZES | AWARDS

- 1) NO cash or money will be awarded.
- 2) TOP TEN will be announced and receive ribbons.
- 3) Winner receives Braggin' Rights and the Sunshine, Smiles & Smoke traveling trophy for a year.

CHICKEN WING THROWDOWN RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1) Anyone can enter. Cook by yourself or as a team.
- 2) Entry fee is \$10.00 per cook/team. YOU supply the chicken wings.
- 3) Fire must be wood or charcoal. No electric or propane.
- 4) Containers will be handed out prior to turn-in.
- 5) You are responsible for observing prudent temperature and sanitary requirements at all times.
- 6) All contestants are expected to respect the rights of all parties involved in the event.
- 7) Each team will consist of a Chief Cook and as many assistants as the Chief Cook deems necessary.
- 8) Chicken wings may be prepped anytime (night before, etc.)

JUDGING

- 1) Entries will be judged by a pre-selected panel of judges.
- 2) Entries will be judged in the areas of a) TASTE b) APPEARANCE
- 3) NO garnish allowed in the turn-in box.
- 4) NO sauce containers will be allowed in the turn-in box.
- 5) Entries may be presented with or without sauce or seasonings.
- 6) If you choose to use a sauce with your chicken wings, sauce must be applied to the wings. Sauce must not be pooled in the container.
- 7) Marking or sculpting of any kind, of the meat or of the container, will not be allowed.
- 8) No aluminum foil or stuffing is allowed in the container.
- 9) No toothpicks, skewers or foreign material are permitted in the container. Any entry not complying with this rule will be disqualified.
- 10) Each team must turn-in 6 individual chicken wings (wings clipped), NO GARNISHMENTS.
- 11) Turn-in time is on or before 12:00 pm sharp. Late entries will not be accepted.

PRIZES | AWARDS

- 1) Winner take all (money) based on number of entries.
- 2) TOP THREE will be announced.
- 3) Winner receives braggin' rights and traveling "Chicken Trophy" for a year.
